Student Overview - How to Access WebEx Session

1.Installing

If you're sent a link to join a session for the first time, you will be prompted to install the program. It's a good idea to install the program before you join that first session. To do this, refer to the Student Guide to Installing the WebEx Training client:

You will only need to do this once for WebEx Training Centre as updates will happen automatically.

2. Running WebEx

WebEx should launch from the session link in the invitation you're sent using these web browsers:

- Microsoft Internet Explorer 11
- Microsoft Edge You might be prompted to allow WebEx to run.

Other browsers:

Chrome If you're using the Google Chrome web browser, you'll need to add a little helper extension which you can get from the Google Chrome store (it's free): https://chrome.google.com/webstore/detail/ciscowebexextension/jlhmfgmfgeifomenelglieieghnjghma

Mozilla Firefox, you'll need to add a little helper add-on which you can get from the Mozilla addons site (it's free):

https://addons.mozilla.org/en-US/firefox/addon/cisco-webex-extension

The Chrome and Firefox helper apps might need you to allow them to run. You should be prompted to do this.

3. Accessing a session.

You may receive an email invitation to join a session or your teacher may provide a link in your Connect Class.


Connect: If your teacher has provided a link in a Connect class go to:

Login and click on the class your session is in. This will open your class then click on the grid image that links to your WebEx session.



Invitation: If you receive an invitation, look for the link to the session. This is highlighted below.

To access your WebEx session you will need to provide your name and your Department email address.



5. Connecting Sound (Audio)


Once in your WebEx session you will need to connect your Audio.

Click the Call Using Computer button




If sound isn't working

In the Audio menu: Choose Speaker Audio Test.



Test your sound: Make sure you've selected the correct devices from the drop-down list (e.g. headset or computer speakers and separate mic). When you're done, click **OK**.



WebEx doesn't need you to 'Click to talk'. Depending on how your teacher has set up the session, your microphone may be on or off when you start the session.

Use the microphone icon on the right of the screen to switch on and off your mic:



Your mic is off when this icon is red:
