In-Term Swimming Lessons

Dear parent and carers

In Weeks 5 and 6 of Term 1, students in Pre-primary to Year 6 will be participating in swimming lessons at Aquamotion in Wanneroo. As a part of the curriculum, these lessons are funded by the Department of Education. However, transport and pool entry is charged to families at \$55.00 per student.

Due to the public holiday on Monday 4th March, the lessons will be a 9-day series. They will be commencing on Monday 26th February and concluding on Friday 8th March.

Students will need to bring the following items labelled with their name:

- Bathers
- Towel
- Thongs or sandals (to wear to the pool – regular shoes required for school)
- Goggles
- Change of clothes (uniform including underwear, shoes and socks)
- Warm Clothing (eg dressing gown/hoodie) to wear on the bus to and from the venue – *not required if weather is hot*
- Separate bag for wet bathers/towel

Please note that students should come to school each day in full school uniform, including shoes. There will be an opportunity for students to change into their bathers at school prior to leaving for the pool.

An enrolment form will be sent home this week for you to complete and return by 12th February. A swimming timetable will be available in the coming weeks. Please note that if you would like to watch your child during their lesson, Aquamotion has a spectator charge of \$2.00.
