

2. Minutes of previous meeting		Correspondence: nil  The minutes of the previous meeting were endorsed by Chris Quelch and seconded by Caitlin Merritt.  The minutes were signed by the Principal and Board Chair.
3. Finance	One line budget statement Funding Agreement Finance Committee membership	The Principal explained one line budget summary. He noted that the \$82,000 variance is actually \$20,000 lower due to a payment, but still within the \$50,000-\$100,000 range that is comfortable.  Funding Agreement was noted.  Finance Committee membership was noted.
4. After School Programs	Code Camp flyer	The Principal raised the suggestion of school offering extracurricular activities provided by private external providers on a user pays basis. The school would receive a small fee for the use of the facilities. Care for Kids were approached for their feedback of the idea and they do not see it as acting in competition to their operation. Suggested offerings were instrumental music lessons and Code Camp.  Board members discussed the costs to parents, but was broadly supportive of the idea.
